

Beers on Tap

Devil's Backbone Vienna Lager- \$6.25 - Great American Beer Festival Silver Medal winner. A chestnut colored lager with a malty aroma and subtle toasty sweetness derived from a multi-stage mash. A pinch of noble hops gives this refreshing beer a clean finish. Local from Nellysford, Virginia.

Basic City Six Lords IPA-\$6.00- Local Virginian IPA slightly hazy amber color; great citrusy hop aroma with nice grapefruit notes; great fruity, citrusy hop flavor; very hop forward with lots of nice grapefruit hop notes and some tropical fruit notes; light, bready malt base

Guinness Stout-\$6.50- Black color with brown reflexes and a light creamy head, the aroma of toasted malt and coffee is pleasant. The body is light and a little fizzy with a toasted bitter taste.

Abita Amber-\$5.75- Munich style lager brewed with crystal malt and Perle hops. It has a smooth, malty, slightly caramel flavor and a rich amber color.

Pale Fire Red Molly Irish Red Ale-\$6.50- Local Harrisonburg, Virginia Irish Red ale starts with authentic Irish Ale malt. Cherry notes and a slight residual sweetness come from Crystal and Munich malts, with a touch of chocolate wheat. A clean bitterness, courtesy of mild British hops, balances the malt complexity and results in a flavorful and refreshing pint.

Brothers Craft "Lil Hellion"-\$6.25- Local Lager from Harrisonburg, Virginia. Lager-Malt aromas with a good touch of clean herbal hops, a bit of sweetness of dough that gets slightly sugary on the nose as well. Slight herb-hops finish.

Allagash White 7.25- Belgian-style wheat beer is brewed with oats, malted wheat, and un-malted raw wheat for a hazy, "white" appearance, spiced with our own special blend of coriander and Curacao orange peel.

Smutty Nose "Brown Dog Ale"-\$6.00- Aroma is rich and malty; the brew smells like brown sugar, toffee, brandy, caramel and dark fruit. The taste is similar to the aroma. The chewy mouthfeel is full and rich with moderate carbonation. It's also smooth and easy to drink.

Local Virginia Craft Beers & Ciders

Bold Rock Virginia Draft Cider-\$5.25- Locally picked Blue Ridge-grown apples result in a clear golden apple cider with aromas of sweet apples. Tastes like sweet sugary apples. Light body with a dry finish "GLUTEN FREE"

Blue Mountain Brewery "Dark Hollow"\$14.00- An Imperial Stout aged in charred American oak bourbon barrels still dripping with uncut whiskey. For 100 days the young beer patiently breathes in and out of the wood, gaining complexity, character, and serious attitude. Local brew from Nellysford Virginia.

Blue Mountain "Full Nelson" Virginia India Pale Ale-\$5.50- Cascade variety hops are one of the key ingredients that give a strong malt backbone, rich taste and vibrant copper color to this ale while the generous addition of hops contribute a pronounced bitterness and floral, citrus aroma.

Brothers Craft "Great Outdoors" Pale Ale-\$5.50- The blend of hops allows a crisp, clean and refreshing taste. Enjoy The Great Outdoors with caramel malt with some tasty hop bitterness. Nice smooth Pale Ale.

Chaos Mountain "Squatch" Scotch Ale-\$5.75- A big malty, dark amber Scottish Ale from Calloway Virginia with complex flavors, a little sweetness and dry finish.

Devil's Backbone Black Lager-\$5.50-German style Schwarzbier with malty taste from roast and caramel malts, slightly sweet with just a bit of bitterness and a clean finish. Light bodied but not thin, with decent carbonation.

O'Connor "El Guapo" Agave IPA-\$6.00- El Guapo is a medium-bodied Agave India Pale Ale with grassy citrus nose, notes of sweet caramel, and finishes with a smooth but strong bitterness.

Star Hill "Jomo Lager"\$5.50- Local Virginia lager, Starr Hill's Jomo Vienna Lager is a smooth, multiple-award-winning Vienna-style lager. Fermented with Southern German Lager yeast, its crisp, clean taste, and noticeable hop aroma are effectively balanced with a slight malty sweetness.

Star Hill "The Love"-\$5.50- The Love is an unfiltered wheat beer, also known as a hefeweizen. It is distinguished by its extremely light body and fruity aroma, finished with spicy notes.

Champion "Shower Beer"-\$4.75- A Czech-style pilsner from Charlottesville with floral, grassy hops; dry, cracker-like malt flavor; and a bit of citrus; there's a more-ish sweetness that invites another sip.

South Street "Satan's Pony"-\$5.50- Malty Amber ale, easy on the palate with a solid bit of malt, caramel, bread, light sweetness and a complimentary touch of hop bitterness with clean, lasting finish.

Craft Beers

Abita "Purple Haze"-\$6.00- Crisp, American style wheat beer with raspberry puree added after filtration. The raspberries provide the lager with a subtle purple coloration and haze, a fruity aroma, and a tartly sweet taste.

Bell's "Two Hearted" IPA-\$6.75- A significant malt body balances this hop presence; together with the signature fruity aromas of Bell's house yeast, this leads to a remarkably drinkable American-style India Pale Ale.

Blue Moon Belgium White-\$4.00- With a hint of orange peel, for a subtle sweetness, added oats, wheat and a hint of coriander create a smooth, creamy finish that's inviting to the palate. Top with an orange slice.

Craft Beers

Founder's Centennial IPA-\$5.25- Creamy head, hazed from the hops with a dark orange tawny hue. It has soft hop oil aroma, clean but pungent citric hop character, warming white pepper alcohol with layers of fruitiness and toasted caramel from middle to end.

Dogfish Head 90 Minute IPA-\$7.99- A bright, firm bouquet with lemon/citrus notes and a bit of toasty malt. The palate is light-bodied, but there is some Munich-malt character along with plenty of lemon and orange-peel hop flavor. The bitterness outweighs the ma.

Flying Dog "Double Dog" Double Pale Ale-\$7.50- Generously hopped ale with a deep red color which pours with a nice frothy head. The abundance of hops will conjure some provocative aromas with hints of raisins and citrus.

Lagunitas "Little Sumpin' Sumpin'" -\$5.25- Truly unique style featuring a strong hop finish on a silky body. A hoppy pale wheat ale that is great for IPA fans but so smooth that the hefeweizen fans dig it too

New Belgium "Citradelic" Tangerine IPA-\$ 5.25-Golden orange in color blend of citrus & tropical fruit and pine hop up front, herbal and caramel notes, starts mildly sweet and transitions to a well-balanced bitterness. Smooth start, lightly dry and a clean finish

Rogue Dead Guy Ale-\$6.75- Amber orange color, very smooth and well balanced. Nicely hopped and overall quite delicious taste.

Rogue Shakespeare Oatmeal Stout 22oz - \$12.99-Ebony in color, a rich creamy head and a mellow chocolate aftertaste. It is made from Northwest Harrington, Crystal, and Chocolate Malts, roasted barley and rolled oats, along with cascade hop.

Sierra Nevada Pale Ale-\$5.25- Aromas of pine, orange peel and grapefruit, hops are pungent but not overwhelming. Bitterness is kept in balance by warm malt and a hint of light caramel. The dry finish is very long with a really nice nuttiness from yeast.

SweetWater "Hash" Session IPA-\$5.50- Golden color with the aroma of citrus fruit and some mild hops, the taste is a crisp citrus beer with some excellent mild hop flavor.

Victory Golden Monkey-\$6.25- Belgian-style triple ale with German malts and Belgian yeast are tempered by a sparkling approach and overall light body with abundant herbal, fruity notes make this one to savor. 9.5%

Imported Beers

Negra Modelo-\$5.00- This Munich Dunkel (dark) style is characterized by its liberal use of roasted or toasted malts. The slow roasting of the malts alone makes the brewing process last twice as long as other beers, producing its signature reddish color and hint of sweetness.

Corona-\$5.00- An easy drinking beer, light in color, flavor and substance; add a lime to bring out the flavor.

Sam Smith's Oatmeal Stout-\$6.99- Opaque black color with a big tan head and taste of roasted malts, oats and very faint chocolate; extremely tasty and filling.

Schneider Weisse 16 oz-\$10.50- Aroma of hops and citrus with a spicy note perfectly balance the malty character with the easiness of the hops. Refreshing and full-bodied at the same time.

Young's Double Chocolate Stout-\$8.25- This stout is deep black-slight brown in color, with aromas of chocolate and coffee beans; creamy with slight chocolate hints in the flavor; a delicious stout.
